
Dear Mr. President,


The State of Missouri received a Major Presidential Disaster Declaration, FEMA-4435-DR, on May 20, 2019. The incident period for this event ended on April 16, 2019. Immediately following, a severe weather event began on April 29, 2019, impacting counties across the state with tornadoes, high winds, flooding, and flash flooding. This event has compounded the damage from the previous event. State and local governments continue to be burdened by the costs that have been incurred in the ongoing effort to protect life and property.

We respectfully request your prompt action to ensure that these communities receive the immediate support needed to respond to the disaster. Along with our fellow Missourians, we appreciate your attention to this request and stand ready to assist in any way possible.


